Bourbon City – Louisville's first distillery since Prohibition opened in the heart of downtown in 2013 signaling a new era in Bourbon in its native home.

The Evan Williams Bourbon Experience became the first distillery the public could tour in Louisville as other brands have joined the Urban Bourbon renaissance. The picturesque Bulleit Frontier Whiskey Experience, rock 'n' roll brandy distillery Copper & Kings, and father-son craft distillery Kentucky Peerless Distilling Co., were soon to follow. The Jim Beam Urban Stillhouse opened a micro distillery and visitor experience at Fourth Street Live!

The Frazier History Museum on Museum Row is the official starting point for the Kentucky Bourbon Trail® with a Welcome Center & Exhibit.

As Louisville's reputation as a food destination has come to garner worldwide recognition, local chefs and entrepreneurs have taken culinary experiences beyond the dining room. Bourbon-themed tour company Mint Julep Tours offers customizable Culinary Artisan Tours to either sample Kentucky's staple dishes or to experience tasting dinners, chef's table experiences or mixology classes.

The accolades continue to grow - from the World Food Travel Association's grand prize award for "Best Destination Experience" to Zagat naming Louisville "one of the top eight 'awesome foodie getaways in the world'" – the only US destination.
