


# HELPING THE HUNGRY, HOMELESS AND ABUSED IN ATLANTIC CITY

This organization is requesting help with paper goods such as paper plates. They disburse over 500 meals each day.

"providing vital services to victims of social justice issues, sexual violence, and sexual assault in Atlantic City and surrounding area, and supporting youth survivors of human trafficking." Because they help the victims of domestic violence – both women and men – they are requesting new bath towels for the victims when they come to AVANZAR.

# DIRECT SHUTTLE BETWEEN PHILLY AIRPORT TO HARRAH'S ATLANTIC CITY



The Transportation Committee has arranged for direct shuttle transportation between the Philadelphia, Pennsylvania airport and Harrah's Atlantic City on Wednesday, Sept. 17 and Sunday, Sept. 21.

### Cost: \$90 per person round trip

Schedule your flights in time to collect your luggage from the baggage area and get on the marked bus. It is approximately a 90-minute drive between Philadelphia and Atlantic City.
